

# It's challenging for aspiring entrepreneurs to find the right tools and exposure that help them start their careers.

A study conducted by **ICAR-NAARM** found that 78% of the participants expressed interest in entrepreneurship, but more than half lacked exposure to entrepreneurial activities. Their motivation stems from passion and independence, with most coming from farming families. Despite high motivation, students from tier II, III, and IV cities and rural areas face significant hurdles, causing their entrepreneurial dreams to falter.





# Eligibility

The aspiring start-ups, students, innovators, seasoned professional and anyone who is working in the field of startup and innovation can participate in this **Hackathon**. There is **no fee** to participate in this **Hackathon**, it is absolutely **FREE** for all startups and innovators.

#### Innovative Idea's category

**Team Size:** Can be an individual applicant or a team of up to 2 students from the same college/university.

**Idea Focus:** The idea should address a specific problem or challenge and offer a unique solution.

**Innovation:** The idea should demonstrate originality and a clear differentiation from existing solutions.

#### **Bankable Idea's category**

**Team Size:** Can be an individual applicant or a team of up to two individuals from university, corporate or early stage working startups

Intent: Participants must have the intent to work on their Business Idea after receiving seed funding in the conclave.
