Q1: What is RISE Hackathon 2.0?

A: Yes, experienced mentors and industry experts will be available to provide guidance and feedback throughout the event.

Q16: How will the projects be judged?

A: Projects will be judged based on several factors, including the innovation of the idea, the

feasibility of the business model, the prototype's functionality, and the potential impact on society.

Awards and Recognition

Q17: What are the prizes for the winners?

A: The top startups will receive exciting prizes and goodies, along with opportunities for further incubation and support from the RISE Jhansi Incubation Center.
